

Petition to Support Springfield-New Haven Commuter Rail

We ask our MA elected officials in the state and federal governments to fully fund the Springfield to New Haven Commuter Rail line and make it a reality.



Connecticut is planning commuter rail service from Enfield to New Haven, linking northern CT with the New York area. To make Springfield a passenger stop on this line, MA needs to invest an estimated \$30 million. CT's share is \$270 million.

It's green – Commuter rail would reduce pollution-emitting traffic on I-91, I-84, and I-95, improving the air we all breathe.

It's good for our economy – The Pioneer Valley Planning Commission estimates that this line would generate at least \$152 million in new economic activity in Western MA.

It's good for riders and employers – Commuter rail gives travelers more convenient and affordable options. It's also a key part of a sustainable transportation system of rail, buses, and cars that employers need to attract the best workers and keep businesses running smoothly.
